

AREAS WHICH WILL ATTEND HOPEWELL ELEMENTARY AND ARE CURRENTLY ASSIGNED TO PLEASANT VIEW ATTENDANCE AREA:

1. **Hopewell School quadrant** (an area north of 53rd; east of school district boundaries with Bettendorf; west of Middle Road; south of I-80). This includes neighborhoods of Valleywynds, Highlands, Highland Green, Beaver Crossing and others.
2. **Crow Creek Park quadrant** (an area south of 53rd; north of Belmont Road; east of Devils Glen; west of Middle Road). This is currently a substantially undeveloped area. It includes homes off Tanglewood Road and others.
3. **Sterling Woods quadrant** (an area north of imaginary line extending Hopewell Ave. to Criswell St., east of Middle Road, west of Criswell St. and south of I-80). This includes existing homes along Middle and Forest Grove Rd., Sterling Woods and others along with a substantial amount of undeveloped land. (Please note: Currently homes north of Forest Grove Road in this quadrant attend Cody.)
4. **Wyndham Hills quadrant** (an area east of Middle Road; south of an imaginary line extending Charter Oaks Dr. to Middle Rd.; north of imaginary line extending Brookview Ct. to an imaginary line extending Cottage Grove Rd. south to their intersection point; east of the imaginary line extending Cottage Grove Rd. south) This area is designated to Hopewell until Hopewell becomes a four section building. At that time Wyndham Hills will be transferred to the Pleasant View attendance area unless circumstances change which dictate another position. This includes existing homes along Brookview Ct.

5. Miscellaneous Protocols

If home access road connects to Criswell St. and is north of imaginary line extending 53rd to Criswell, then students are assigned to Hopewell. If the home access road connects to Criswell St. and is south of the imaginary line extending 53rd Ave. to Criswell, then students will attend Pleasant View. The east/west boundary of this section will be determined by the development of southern connections from the extension of Hopewell Ave. or other roads. Until such connections exist students living in homes built in this area which do not connect off Criswell but rather do connect off 53rd Ave., may be assigned to Pleasant View. If home access road connects to Wells Ferry students will attend Cody, which is current assignment. The area south of US 67, east of current Pleasant View boundary and west of 249th St. will be assigned to Pleasant View (currently the assignment is Bridgeview.) This includes homes on Harbor Drive and Spencer Road.

OF SPECIAL NOTE

Schaefer Farm's transition (an area north of Crow Creek Road; south of 53rd Ave.; west of Devils Glen Rd. and east of district boundaries with Bettendorf). It is the district's intention to move Schaefer Farms from Pleasant View to Hopewell. Moving Schaefer Farms into Hopewell at the current time (with Hopewell as a two section building) would cause Hopewell to fill too quickly. Therefore when Hopewell is expanded to a four section building (estimated between 5-8 years from the opening of the building) Schaefer Farms will be moved to the Hopewell attendance area. Until that time Schaefer Farms will remain at Pleasant View unless circumstances change which dictate another position.

AREAS WHICH WILL BE ASSIGNED TO CODY AND ARE CURRENTLY ASSIGNED TO BRIDGEVIEW ATTENDANCE AREA:

1. **Trout Valley quadrant** (an area south of I-80; north of Forest Grove Rd.; east of Wells Ferry Rd.; west of existing Cody boundary). This includes homes along Forest Grove, the Trout Valley neighborhood, Van Villa Ct., Brown Ct. and others.
2. **Davenport Country Club quadrant** (an area north of Valley Drive including homes on south side if access point is Valley Drive; south of Forest Grove Road; East of Wells Ferry and west of 35th St. including the area east of 35th if homes access point is from 35th). This includes homes along Valley Dr., Woods at Fox Hollow neighborhood and homes along 35th St.

IMPORTANT RELATED POLICIES

1. **Attendance area policy for 2010-11 and beyond** – If there is not room in the school assigned to your home, you will be assigned to the next closest elementary with room and provided district transportation (unless within walk zone) until spot(s) open in your home school (satisfactory to accommodate the whole family) which is available at the start of the new school year. Refusal of that spot means loss of specific stop transportation services.
2. **Grandfathering** – When Hopewell opens the expectation is that all students will move to their newly assigned building. The district will only provide transportation to a different building in the instance where there is no room in the neighborhood school and will discontinue transportation when room is available at the start of a new school year (for the whole family). Special parental request exemptions will only be considered when there is a clear advantage to the child, family and district.
3. **Shuttles** – When Hopewell opens the district intends to eliminate general education shuttles between buildings except in the instances when space is not available in neighborhood school. This includes the Bridgeview/Cody shuttle.
4. **Timeline** – All of these changes will take effect with the opening of Hopewell.
5. **Walk Zones** – As boundary work is finished, the district will also be evaluating existing walk zones to facilitate greater transportation efficiency.
