Re: H1N1 Vaccine Appointments Available for Select Priority Groups

The Scott County Health Department is continuing to receive shipments of H1N1 vaccine. This is not the seasonal vaccine, but vaccine against the new 2009 H1N1 virus. Vaccine will be provided to individuals in the priority groups listed below by appointment only at clinics to be held this week and next week. Appointments will be made on a first come first served basis.

Expanded priority populations this week include: Healthy children/young adults 6 months to **24 years old**

Continued priority populations that will be scheduled include:

- Individuals with chronic disease to include those from 6 months to **64 years old**
 - Chronic disease includes:
 - chronic pulmonary disease (including asthma)
 - metabolic disorders (including diabetes mellitus)
 - cardiovascular disease (except isolated high blood pressure)
 - kidney disease
 - liver disease
 - chronic cognitive impairment (like Alzheimer’s Disease and other dementia, Down Syndrome or Autism)
 - neurologic/neuromuscular diseases
 - blood disorders
 - immunosuppression (including immunosuppression caused by medications like steroids and chemotherapy or by human immunodeficiency virus)
- Pregnant women
- Household contacts and caregivers of infants less than six months old
- Health care workers with direct patient contact
