**To Qualify, You Must:**

- ★ Be a PVCHS student interested in Automotive Technology
- ★ Be a senior at PVCHS
- ★ Submit a transcript of credits reflecting seven semesters of work
- ★ Maintain a “B” average in Industrial Technology
- ★ Plan to attend a college or vocational school upon graduation and enroll in a automotive technology program
- ★ The scholarship is a tuition scholarship and will be paid directly to the institution
- ★ The scholarship will be granted for one year

**Make application and return to the Guidance Office by March 3, 2008.**

**Please be aware that some scholarship search committees check social networking profiles as a reference.**

The Jacob Cooper Littrell Memorial Scholarship is self-perpetuating from a non-profit trust fund established by the family in 2005. The scholarship is funded by interest income generated by the trust. It is projected that the minimum amount of the scholarship will be \$500.00 annually.

The scholarship recipient will be determined by a scholarship committee composed of the following staff members of Pleasant Valley High School:

- ★ High School Principal either or High School Associate Principal
- ★ A Guidance Counselor
- ★ Industrial Technology Instructor

The scholarship is open to Pleasant Valley Community High School seniors who have participated in the Industrial Technology Program and who plan to continue their education in Automotive Technology. The scholarship is for tuition only and will be paid directly to the institution that the recipient attends. The scholarship is non-renewable. Should the scholarship committee decide that there are no eligible recipients in a given year, the monies will remain invested in the fund to earn interest for future recipients.

Eligible students must make application to the principal of Pleasant Valley Community High School by March 3rd of the year of their graduation. Application forms will be available in the guidance office at the high school. The scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the Senior Awards Program held prior to commencement. A memorial plaque listing the scholarship recipients will be displayed at the high school.
