Handout and Map-

You are expected to write all countries, capitals, and bodies of water correctly. The capitals are listed in the back of our classroom atlases. Please follow all directions on your handout and map.

All map coloring needs to be done lightly with colored pencils. The names of the countries, points of interest, and bodies of water need to be clearly seen and can not be abbreviated. You do not need to write the names of the capitals on the map.

1. On your map write the names of the countries, points of interest, and bodies of water as neatly as you can.
2. Color the following countries purple: Iraq, Egypt, Oman, Tajikistan, and Ethiopia.
3. Color the following countries orange: Iran, Syria, Yemen, Bahrain, and India.
4. Color the following countries green: Jordan, Qatar, Afghanistan, Eritrea, and Kuwait.
5. Color the following countries yellow: Lebanon, Saudi Arabia, Pakistan, Uzbekistan, and Djibouti.
6. Color the following countries red: Turkey, Israel, United Arab Emirates, Turkmenistan, Sudan, and Somalia.
7. Place the names of the following points of interest and bodies of water on the map: Arabian Sea, Black Sea, Caspian Sea, Mediterranean Sea, Persian Gulf, Red Sea, Indian Ocean, and Suez Canal. Color the water light blue.

Test

You will be given a map of the Middle East with numbers on each country. These numbers will not be the same as the other Middle East map. You will need to know the location of the 26 countries and the 8 bodies of water. You will only need to know 14 capitals:

Abu Dhabi, Amman, Ankara, Baghdad, Beirut, Cairo, Damascus, Islamabad, Jerusalem, Kabul, Kuwait City, Riyadh, Tashkent, and Tehran.
